You will need to provide your name and the reasoning for your absence.





Emily Brown - Clinical Coach





STUDENT EMAIL

All students will receive a student email account when they begin their induction. This will be their first initial followed by their surname @rvnc.co.uk. We recommend using Mozzila Thunderbird to run your student account on. All the information you need and any help will be available during your induction.

VLE

The college VLE (Virtual Learning Environment) will be a platform accessible through the college website, www.rvnc.co.uk. On here you will be able to access tools and resources related to your course including mock exams, portfolio and learning aids for individual modules.

IT SUPPORT

IT Support will be on hand 7 days a week for students who are struggling with any of the college resources. Any problems with your email, VLE or any other college accounts should be reported to Macauley Bowers who will be able to assist in rectifying any problems.

PRINTING

Any printing you require for college work can be done when working in practice. Each surgery you work at will be equipped with printing, photocopying and scanning capabilities. We do ask you try print everything in black and white to keep costs down.

MICROSOFT TEAMS

In the event you are unable to attend class for whatever reason, you will still be able to attend your lecture via Microsoft Teams. The meeting will be set up for you and an instruction document sent to you showing you how to access the meeting. This is a last resort thing and we stress all students do the best they can to attend the class in person.

SAFE EXAM BROWSER

When undertaking exams, each student will be required to have Safe Exam Browser (SEB) installed on their computer. Without this software you will be unable to complete your exam. In the morning of any exam your computer will be set up on the SEB for you ready for you to sign in. Any assistance in installing and setting up the SEB can be requested during your induction.





